

Summer Fencing Intensives: Schedule & Fees

Pre-Season Training Clinic: Competitive Epee Ages 10 to 16

We are pleased to offer two Pre-Season Competitive Epee Training Clinics, in a five-day format. These intensives help competitive fencers prepare for the upcoming fencing season. Emphasis is on technique and tactical experience, tournament competition and maximizing competitive success. Strategy and tactics, bout structure, time management and conditioning are paramount.

Any Competitive Epee Fencer aged 10 to 16 is encouraged to attend one or both of these clinics.

Each Intensive Program is limited to 14 fencers. Sessions are filled on a first come, first served basis. Please register early to ensure enrollment in the session of your choice.
